

**The next Central Management Committee and the 27<sup>th</sup> Competent  
Authorities for Medical Devices Meeting  
(Budapest)**

Related to the Hungarian Presidency of the European Union, the Department of Medical Devices of the Office of Health Authorisation and Administrative Procedures is going to host the Central Management Committee on Medical Devices (CMC – 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2011.) and Competent Authorities for Medical Devices (CAMD – 24-25<sup>th</sup> February 2011.) meetings in the first half of the year 2011 in Budapest.

- 23<sup>rd</sup> February. CMC meeting

The CMC is the highest level operative forum of the competent authorities of the member states. It is established by the competent authorities and empowered to bring and represent decisions in ongoing or forthcoming cases. It consists of one delegated expert of each competent authority. The Committee has four meetings in a year. Two of them are bound to the CAMD meeting during that country's presidency, the other two in between are bound to the meetings of the Medical Device Expert Group.

- 24-25<sup>th</sup> February. 27<sup>th</sup> CAMD meeting

The Competent Authorities of Medical Devices meeting is a high level forum of the heads of the competent authorities where strategic questions of the medical device regulation, results of the various workgroups are discussed. The meeting has formal and informal part so the invited high officials can discuss the way of their better cooperation, exchange views about their ongoing domestic cases, details of the specialities of their regulations, etc.
